CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS E. A. Honrath has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and pipe lines for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 4, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 4, bears N. 4° 14' W., 995.00 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s. or 60 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 8, 1944

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 758 feet deep cased with 300 feet of 8 inch casing and 708 feet of 4 inch casing. A distribution system consisting of approximately 850 feet of 6 inch pipe, with 2 inch outlets for each plat, conveys the water from the well to each of the ten one acre plats into which portions of the S 1/2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 4, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., have been subdivided.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
