CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. V. Tallman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditch system for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 35 N., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of said Section 36, bears S. 0° 15' W., 1,885.00 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.7037 c.f.s. or 342 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from March 1 to October 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 25, 1947

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 4 columns: Area, NE 1/4, SW 1/4, and other quadrant details. Rows include 10.97 acres total and sub-allocations of 7.38, 34.34, 10.90, and 6.78 acres.

NOTE: Water is developed by means of a 6' x 6' dug well 20 feet deep and equipped with a Parma water lifter having a capacity of 500 gallons per minute. The lifter discharges the water into a ditch system.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
