

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Stuart L. Williams, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deep Tunnel through pipe lines for Mining, Milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 30 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Section Corner of said Section 30, bears N. 36° 14' W., 2,025.97 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a long tunnel approximately 7,465 feet long that was driven to tap the Coalition Mine and other mines in the Seven Troughs Mining District. Approximately 6,500 feet of 4 inch pipe conveys the water to the portal of the tunnel; thence by 400 feet of open ditch; thence by a 2 inch pipe line to the main cyanide plant and a 5-stamp amalgamation mill; thence by a 2 inch pipe line to the Caustin Mill. A second 2 inch pipe line conveys the water to the Fire Line; thence by a 1 inch pipe line to the office, boarding house and cottages. The Tucker and Caustin cottages are supplied with water through a 3/4 inch pipe line from the Caustin Mill. All the places of use are located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 30 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
