**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Carl S. Myers has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rattlesnake Spring through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 31 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Section Corner of Section 18, T. 31 S., R. 66 E., bears S. 77° 31' E., 16,769.3 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Carl S. Myers

Post-office address Searchlight, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0006 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 20 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 17, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring is developed by means of an open cut 90 feet long and conveyed by means of 90 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a circular trough 3 feet in diameter and 1 foot deep, located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 31 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
