CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Deep Well) through well, pump, pipe line, tank, trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, T. 1 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Section Corner of Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 53 E., bears N. 60° 27' W., 11,360.54 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Fallini Brothers
Post-office address: Twin Springs, Via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 16, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 470 feet deep and cased with 465 feet of 6 inch casing. Equipped with 440 feet of 3 inch column and pump jack powered by a gasoline engine. Water is pumped into a 10,000 gallon steel storage tank; thence to a stockwatering trough 5' x 5' x 18' and located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, T. 1 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
