CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank A. Brunetti has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (2 Wells) through pumps, pipe lines, troughs, ponds for Commercial Fish Hatchery

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 5, bears S. 5° 14' 18" W., 550 feet; and S. 11° 18' 56" W., 725.8 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of two wells. Well No. 1 has been drilled to a depth of 197 feet and cased with 187 feet of 6 inch casing. Equipped with an electrically driven turbine pump that discharges the water into a 6 inch pipe line that conveys the water to the hatchery storage tank. Well No. 2 has been dug and is equipped with a 4 inch centrifugal pump powered by an electric motor and a standby gasoline engine. This pump discharges the water into a 4 inch pipe line that conveys it to the hatchery storage tank where it is comingled with the water from well No. 1; thence through hatching troughs in the hatchery; thence through raceways; thence by two 10 inch drain pipes and a concrete flume the water is conveyed to a series of 10 rearing ponds, each separated by concrete spillways. A concrete flume conveys the water from the last rearing pond to a large open rearing pond; thence by natural drain to the North Truckee Ditch.

- (a) From January 1 to April 30 incl. 1.34 c.f.s. is pumped from Well No. 1 for hatching purposes. (b) From May 1 to August 31 incl. 2.23 c.f.s. is pumped from both wells and is used for the main troughs and rearing ponds. (c) From September 1 to December 31 incl. 0.89 c.f.s. is pumped from Well No. 2 and is used to supply water to the reduced stock of fish. The total yearly consumption of water is limited to 803 acre feet.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
