CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alma Woods has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek through dam and ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31, T. 19 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Section Corner of said Section 31, bears N. 3° 12' E., 1,504.00 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s. or 24.354 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from May 1 to August 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 13, 1947

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
10.00 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 19 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
