CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. van der Smissen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through pump and ditch system for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Section Corner of said Section 17, bears S. 52° 47' 20" W., 2,261.00 feet, situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 46 Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Directors of the State Orphans' Home of the State of Nevada.

Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.3041 c.f.s. or 182.46 acre feet per annum.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 22, 1944

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

0.91 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.
7.76 " " " SE 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " "
21.74 " " " NE 1/4 NW 1/4 " 20, " " "
30.41 acres total.

NOTE: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 608 feet deep and cased with 374 feet of 10 inch casing, 140 feet of 12 inch casing and 80 feet of 18 inch casing. Equipped with a vertical type 40 H.P. Pump with a rated capacity of 2,000 gallons per minute or 4.456 c.f.s.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
