CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sage Hen Spring through sump, pipe line and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 17, bears N. 35° 50' W., 2,064.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Rex B. Clark and Emma J. Clark
Post-office address Arlemont Ranch, Dyer, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0133 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head cattle and 25 horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 10, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected by means of a sump from which 140 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water to a half round trough 16 feet long, 4 feet wide and 1.5 feet deep located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
