CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mato Kusick has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Horseshutem Spring through pipe line and tank for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 17 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Johnnie, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 6, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Approximately 6 miles of 3 inch and 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water from the spring to a 2,000 gallon metal storage tank; thence by 400 feet of 1/2 inch pipe to the town of Johnnie, Nevada, where it is used for domestic purposes in two houses, for the traveling public and for the irrigation of shade trees, orchard and garden, all located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 18 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
