CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. M. Crosby has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and ditches for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 22 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Section Corner of said Section 18, bears S. 67° 54' E., 2,025.3 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
2.00 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 22 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M.
16.00 " " " NW 1/4 SW 1/4 " " " " "
18.00 acres total.

Most of the above described land is covered by Cert. No. 1600, subject of Permit No. 6627, for the waters of Piute Creek. In the event waters of both sources are used to irrigate the land in question, the total amount that can be used shall be limited to 4.00 acre feet per acre per annum.

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 161 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 3 inch Berkeley turbine pump powered by an air cooled 15 H.P. Butane Engine that pumps the water into a portable aluminum pipe sprinkler system that irrigates 21.4 acres in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T. 22 N., R. 22 E., under Certificate No. 3588, subject of Permit No. 12743. The flood waters from this process of irrigation, flow down a ravine and are diverted into a ditch system for the irrigation of the above described land.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
