CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank D. Rathbun, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipe line, pressure tank for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 6, bears S. 70° 48' 15" E., 1,243.6 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 26, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 318 feet deep and cased with 41 feet of 8 inch casing and 246 feet of 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 3 H.P. Berkeley turbine pump that discharges the water into a 1,000 gallon pressure tank; thence by 285 feet of 1 1/2 inch iron pipe and 110 feet of 3/4 inch pipe to a residence and lawn. A ditch system around the boundaries of the property serve to convey the water to trees and less than 5 acres of cultivated area in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
