CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James E. Stead has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Springs Creek through reservoir and ditch system for Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point on the southerly end of the dam from which the NW Corner of Section 4, T. 21 N., R. 22 E., bears N. 64° 54' W., 7,932.00 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Water is stored in a reservoir having a capacity of 14.5 acre feet created by the construction of an earthen dam across the channel of Twin Springs channel and located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 3, T. 21 N., R. 22 E. The dam is 26 feet high, 415 feet long, and equipped with a 12 inch siphon over the top of the dam. Water can be cumulated throughout the entire year in order to conserve water to the extent of 360 acre-feet per annum for land having a claimed vested water right and covered by Proof of Appropriation No. 02333, showing a priority prior to the year 1882.

** The above described lands as indicated are also irrigated under Certificate No. 3663 issued under Permit No. 11653 and the total amount of water from all sources used thereon shall not exceed 6 acre-feet per acre.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
