CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Annie Fulstone has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (artesian well) through well and ditch system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE 1/4 Corner of Section 2, T. 10 N., R. 23 E., bears S. 14° 22' W., 3,482.1 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from: March 15 to: October 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 25, 1948

*Note:- Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 129 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. A ditch system running northerly and westerly from the well serve the above described land with supplemental water that has a decreed water right from the West Fork of the Walker River. The ditch systems are connected with laterals that divert from ditches that divert directly from the West Fork of the Walker River.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
