CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, ARMANDO A. FRANCISCO has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, storage tank, pipeline, trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 10 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Section Corner of said Section 22, bears N. 13° 30' W., 5,045.00 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Armando A. Francisco
Post-office address: Round Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00625 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 200 cattle
Period of use, from: September 1 to May 1 of following year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 23, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 60 feet deep and cased with 6 inch casing. Equipped with a 2 1/2 inch cylinder and pump jack, powered by a 6 H.P. Briggs & Stratton gas engine. Water is pumped to a 2,500 gallon storage tank; thence by a 2 inch pipeline to a metal stockwatering trough 18' x 2', located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 10 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
