

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James H. Davis has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wagon Tire Springs through ditch and pond for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 39 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of said Section 20, bears S. 50° 00' E., 2,712.00 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James H. Davis and W. B. McKnight
Post-office address Cedarville, California
Amount of appropriation 0.015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle and horses
Period of use, from March 15 to November 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 1, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is conveyed by means of 50 feet of ditch to an earthen stock-watering pond, 15 feet long, 10 feet wide and 4 feet deep, and located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 39 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
