CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER


WHEREAS, Otto L. Hussman, Agent for Henry Seeman, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from waste water from the Gardnerville-Minden sewage disposal plant through concrete headgate and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 13 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 29, bears N. 16° 23' W., 1,457.30 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s. or 64 acre feet per season
Period of use, from March 1 to October 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 11, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 16.00 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 13 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.,



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
