CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS William J. Johnstone, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 4) through well, pump, ditch system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 16 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 3, bears N. 11° 19' E., 2,516.7 feet.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

\*The water from Well No. 4 is comingled with the water from Well No. 3, and the total amount of water that can be used in any one year on the above described land shall not exceed 5 acre feet per acre from all sources, whether by Carson River Decree or by Certificate No. 3689. Note: A drilled well 315 feet deep and cased with 16 1/2 feet of 16 inch casing and 181 feet of 12 inch casing. Equipped with pumping facilities.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
