CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Julien Blaye, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 5) through well, pump and ditch system for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, or NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 40 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of Section 34, T. 41 N., R. 64 E., bears N. 30° 20' E., 6,484.00 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The U. C. Land and Cattle Company, Wilkins & Associates, Owners

Post-office address: Wilkins, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.08 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 23, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 122 feet deep and cased with 12 inch casing. Equipped with a diesel engine driven deep well pump, that discharges the water into a ditch system that serves to water livestock in addition to serving the land under Permit No. 12231.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
