CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Amargosa Tunnel) through tunnel and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T. 11 S., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 21, bears S. 32° 00' E., 2,442.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:
