CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Myra McCue, wife of William J. McCue has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Wells Nos. 1 & 2) through wells, pumps and pipe lines for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 30, bears N. 25° 23' 36" W., 974.3 feet and N. 17° 12' 43" W., 1,230.9 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William J. McCue

Amount of appropriation: 0.0044 c.f.s. or not to exceed 0.0088 acre feet per day
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 26, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of Well No. 1, dug to a depth of 35 feet and 4' x 4'. Equipped with an electrical driven pressure pump with a 1 inch intake that discharges the water into a pipe line leading to houses and yard hydrants. Hoses from hydrants conveys the water to ditches for the irrigation of 3 acres of trees and garden in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 20 N., R. 20 E. Water is also developed by means of Well No. 2, dug to a depth of 35 feet and 6' x 6'. Equipped with an electrical driven pressure pump and system, with a 1 1/2 inch intake that discharges the water into a pipe line that conveys it direct to cabins and yard hydrants. Hoses from hydrants conveys the water to the above named ditch system, and the irrigation of the above described land.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
