CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Trail Creek

through dam, pipe line and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, unsurveyed, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 7, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., bears S. 67° 20' E., 13,550.00 feet, situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 80 head of cattle
Period of use, from June 15 to September 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 2, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A plank dam has been constructed across the channel of Trail Creek that diverts the water into 150 feet of 2 inch pipe that conveys it to a stockwatering trough 10' x 3' x 2', located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
