CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Kellogg Well) through windmill, cylinder, pipeline, trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T. 1 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 28, bears S. 90 40' E., 2,940.00 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle & 25 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 21, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well, equipped with a 2 inch cylinder with a 12 inch stroke, and powered by a windmill. The water is discharged into 20 feet of 2 inch pipe that conveys it to a half-round stockwatering trough 10' x 2 1/2' x 18" located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T. 1 S., R. 35 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
