CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Wm. Fred Moon and Hattie G. Moon, have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, pipe line and tank for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 19, bears S. 82° 28' E., 1,156.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. or not to exceed 18 acre feet per year
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 15, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep and cased with 51 feet of 8 inch casing. Equipped with a 1 H. P. Jet pump and an 80 gallon pressure tank, 200 feet of 1 inch pipe and 200 feet of 3/4 inch pipe conveys the water to one house and 3 acres of garden, lawn and trees in the W 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
