CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, F. M. Fulstone, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, tank, and pipe line for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Section Corner of Section 24, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., bears N. 61° 23' 40" W., 11,724.00 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.20 c.f.s. or not to exceed 120 acre feet per year

Period of use, from Domestic Jan. 1 to November 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 24, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

13.00 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19, T. 11 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.
12.00 " " " NE 1/4 NE 1/4 " 30 " " " " " " " "
5.00 " " " NW 1/4 NE 1/4 " " " " " " " " "

*30.00 acres total.

*The above described land has a decreed water right from the West Fork of the Walker River and the water from this underground water source is used as a supplemental supply. The total amount of water that can be used for irrigation in any one year shall be limited to 4 acre feet per acre from both sources.

Note: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 130 feet deep and cased with 4 inch casing. Equipped with an electric driven 2 inch centrifugal pump, a 550 gallon pressure tank and 600 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe that conveys the water to the slaughter house and the West Walker River ditch system. Water is also conveyed to several stockwatering troughs located near the well.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
