CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, F. M. Fulstone, President has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lower Mud Spring through pipe line, trough, and pond for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 6 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Section corner of Section 24, T. 6 N., R. 28 E., bears N. 70° 32' E., 9,279.3 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.007 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2,400 head of sheep of the following

Period of use, from December 1 to June 1 ~~each~~ year

Date of priority of appropriation October 10, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring has been dug out and boxed, and 100 feet of 1 inch pipe conveys the water to 80 feet of sheep watering troughs. One levee has been constructed a short distance below the troughs that forms a stockwatering pond. A second levee has been constructed about 200 feet lower down forming a second stockwatering pond, all located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 6 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.


