CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald E. Beard has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, pressure tank, pipelines for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner of said Section 12, bears S. 5° 10' W., 2,278.6 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 31, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 460 feet deep and cased with 80 feet of 8 inch and 348 feet of 6 inch casing. Equipped with an electric driven pump, that discharges the water into a 600 gallon pressure tank equipped with two outlets. 100 feet of 3 inch pipe conveys the water from one outlet to a point where this pipeline branches; one branch of 50 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water to a house; the second branch of 175 feet of two inch pipe conveys the water to a swimming pool. The drainage from the swimming pool is used to irrigate a garden. 150 feet of 3/4 inch pipe conveys the water from the second pressure tank outlet to a guest house. 3 acres of landscape, garden and orchard located in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 22 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. are irrigated

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
