

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. A. Shiner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, pressure tank, pipelines for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the North 1/4 Corner of said Section 19, bears N. 3° 53' E., 1,730.00 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation December 27, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 130 feet deep and cased with 8 inch casing. Equipped with a 2 H.P. Morland jet pump that discharges the water into a 315 gallon pressure tank; thence by 150 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe and 200 feet of 3/4 and 1/2 inch pipe to a home and a sprinkler system that irrigates 2 acres of grain, trees and shrubs located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
