CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. Schmittlein has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from \_\_\_\_\_ an underground source through well, pipeline, trough for \_\_\_\_\_ stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 16 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW Corner of Section 23, T. 16 N., R. 44 E., bears N. 77° 09' W., 6,739.41 feet.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Austin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 8, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 120 feet deep and cased with 5 1/2 inch casing. The well flows about 5 gallons per minute. 12 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe conveys the water to a redwood stockwatering trough, 8 feet long, 1 1/2 feet wide and 1 1/2 feet deep, located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 16 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
