CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Merrill H. Peterson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ash Tree Spring through cut, pipeline and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 17 S., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 35, bears S. 56° 57' E., 963.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46 Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Death Valley, California
Amount of appropriation 0.0025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 80 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 28, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a cut 100 feet long, and a 3/4 inch pipeline conveys the water from the back end of the cut to a 7' x 7' concrete stockwatering trough located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 17 S., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
