CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. A. Blair has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Cow Canyon Spring through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 9 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of T. 10 N., R. 51 E., bears N. 69° 10' E., 18,280.00 feet.

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. A. Blair
Post-office address Hot Creek Ranch, Via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring has been cleaned and rocked up. Ten feet of 1 inch pipe conveys the water to a steel stockwatering trough, located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T. 9 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M. Small check dams are installed in the channel that runs in a westerly direction from the trough forming stockwatering ponds.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
