Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Three earth and rock dams are constructed across the channel leading in a westerly direction from the spring forming three stockwatering pools all located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T. 9 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
