CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. D. Baker, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 417 or Well No. 3) Las Vegas Artesian Basin through well, pipelines and storage tank for quasi-municipal

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 4, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of said Section 4, bears S. 47° 14' W., 1,587.00 feet. situated in Clerk County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:



Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 9, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 795 feet deep and cased with 786 feet of casing. Equipped with a 25 H.P. pump that discharges the water into a 10 inch main that conveys it to a 500,000 gallon tank; thence by miscellaneous-sized pipe lines to buildings, hydrants, shops and other air base facilities located in portions of Sections 3, 4, 9 & 10, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
