CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed seeps (near Cowcamp) through trenches, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 32, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., bears S. 83° 00' W., 5,808.00 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Waldo Bozarth and Oscar Rudnick
Post-office address: Ivanpah, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 75 head of cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 8, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of several trenches and cuts from 10 feet to 30 feet long. Water is conveyed from the trenches and cuts by means of a 1 1/2 inch pipe line to a redwood stockwatering tank, 8 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep and located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
