CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James M. Daniels has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Stonewall Spring through pipeline and pond for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 4 S., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of T. 4 S., R. 44 E., bears S. 88° 20' W., 9,255.00 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 15 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 25, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring by means of 200 feet of 2 inch pipe to a stockwatering pond, 20 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 4 S., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
