CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert A. Allen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, storage tanks, pipelines for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 Corner of Section 4, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., bears N. 8° 35' 5.85" E., 5,829.22 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The Roman Catholic Bishop of Reno, and his successors a corporation sole. Post-office address: Reno, Nevada

\* Amount of appropriation: 0.134 c.f.s. or 17.5 acre-feet per season Domestic Jan. 1 Dec. 31 Irrigation Mar. 1 to Oct. 1 of each year Date of priority of appropriation: March 25, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 165 feet deep. Equipped with a Berkeley L-248 vertical pump, having capacity of 60 gallons per minute through a 3 inch outlet, and powered by a 3 H.P. electric motor. Water is discharged into approximately 6 feet of 3 inch pipe that convey it to a steel pressure tank, 44 inches in diameter and 14 feet long, having a capacity of 1,105 gallons; thence by 150 feet of 2 inch pipe to a school building serving approximately 150 people. A second 3 inch pipeline, 10 feet long leading directly from the pump, conveys the water to a concrete storage tank, 14' x 14' x 10', having a capacity of 14,662 gallons; thence by approximately 200 feet of 3 inch pipe to 5 acres of orchard and grass lands located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

\*The irrigated land has a Truckee River Decreed Right under Claim No. 613, from the Glendale ditch, and the total amount of water that can be used during any one season from both sources shall not exceed 3.50 acre-feet per acre.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
