CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. W. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Joe's Well) through well, pump, storage tank, pipe, tank for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 4 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of Section 30, T. 4 N., R. 51 E., bears S. 75° 57' W., 7,677.86 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Twin Springs via Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 137 feet deep and cased the entire depth with 5 inch casing. Equipped with 129 feet of 3 inch column and pump jack, powered by a gasoline engine. Water is discharged into a 10,000 gallon steel storage tank; thence by pipe line to a steel stockwatering trough 16' x 5' x 2 1/2' located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 4 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
