CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John P. Ames has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pump, pipeline and pressure tank for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Section 13, bears S. 16° 04' W., 853.00 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:


Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 190 feet deep and cased with 105 feet of 8 inch casing. Equipped with an electric pump that pumps the water into a pressure tank and thence to one residence and a small lawn located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
