purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which Quartz Peak bears N. 3° 10' E., 36,952.00 feet

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 16, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Extending an excavation under a cliff, Installing a concrete pick up diversion apron into lower rock basin; thence by overflow pipes to two stockwatering tanks located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T. 13 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
