WHEREAS T. A. McCall has presented to the State Engineer
of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
White Mound Springs

through two cuts for
Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12,
T. 17 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner
of said Section 12 bears N. 34° E., 1,120.00 feet

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of
1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Death Valley Junction, California

Amount of appropriation 0.0015 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 6, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water from two adjacent springs is developed by means of two adjacent
cuts approximately 10 feet wide by 20 feet long and 3 feet deep, where
it is conserved for watering 200 cattle and 20 horses. Place of use
is in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T. 17 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed
the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which
acquired.
