CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry Richman, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from East Spring

through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the closing corner on North Line of NW 1/4 Sec. 34 on West Res. Line bears N. 20° 59' E. 4454 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Harry Richman

Post-office address Riverside Hotel, Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0031 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 17, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is conveyed from the spring by a 1 1/2 inch pipe 16 feet long to two semicircular steel troughs 16 feet long. The place of use is at the troughs in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
