CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dale L. Warburton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Camp Spring through tank, pipelines & troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the approximate NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 33 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which Rock Spring bears N. 84° 39' 51" W., 6,241.59 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 22, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner, and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a tunnel 75 feet into the mountain side where the water is collected in a 50 gallon concrete tank. The water is then piped out to two 500 gallon watering troughs with approximately 75 feet of 1 inch pipe. The place of use is at the troughs in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
