CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Julian Goicoechea, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cracker Johnson Spring No. 1 through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 25 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 17, T. 24 N., R. 57 E., bears S. 3° 07' W., 23,950 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Pete and Julian Goicoechea
Post-office address Warm Springs Ranch, Newark Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 cattle and 2000 sheep
Period of use, from April 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 31, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
80 feet of 2" pipe carries the water from the spring to 50' of 2 1/2" sheep troughs. The place of use is at the troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
