CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Bona Well) through well, pump and tank for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Sec. 27, T. 5 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 27 bears N. 45° 20' W., 121 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Smokey Valley, Via Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 30, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a driven well equipped with a gasoline driven pump jack with 2" cylinder which discharges the water into a 1000 gallon tank. The place of use is in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
