CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, H. L. Titus, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Limestone Spring through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, T. 11 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 33, T. 12 N., R. 51 E., M.D.M., unsurveyed, bears N. 37° 24' E., 14,583 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle

Period of use, from June 1 to September 15 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 24, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water from the spring is conveyed through 50 feet of 2 inch pipe into a 30 foot trough located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T. 11 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
