CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, H. L. Titus, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sands Springs Valley Wash (Narrows Catch Basin) through catch basin for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 7 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE corner of T. 10 N., R. 52 E., M.D.M., bears N. 14° 45' W., 88,685 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0012 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of

Period of use, from April 1 to June 1 and September 1 to December 1 of each year cattle

Date of priority of appropriation July 24, 1917

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is developed by means of a catch basin which was excavated 5 feet deep, 15 feet wide and 100 feet long. The place of use is at the catch basin in the same legal subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
