**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, H. L. Titus, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sand Springs Valley Wash (Logan Catch Basin) through catch basin for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW¹ NE¹ Sec. 8, T. 8 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SE corner of T. 10 N., R. 52 E., M.D.M., bears N. 13° 45' W., 38,447 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0012 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
April 1 to June 1 and

Period of use, from September 1 to December 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 24, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is stored in an earthen tank which was excavated 6 feet deep, 30 feet wide and 1100 feet long. The place of use is at the tank in the same legal subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
