CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank M. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring Creek

through Dams, ponds and pipeline for Fish Rearing

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 12 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 15 bears N. 60° 22' W., 2,975 feet

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Nevada Fish and Game Commission

Amount of appropriation 3.0 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 11, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of concrete weir type diversion dams constructed with screened intake into 12" concrete pipe on 1 percent grade to 5' by 8' concrete collecting box thence in launder to ponds (troughs 8' wide and 190' long) and by concrete pipe back to natural channel. The places of use are within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 12 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
