CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes, Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____
Underground (West Well)
through well, pump, pipeline and trough for _____
Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 23 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which an Angle Point on the Von Schmidt State Line survey of 1873 bears S. 5°00' W., 8,976 feet
situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Forrest H. Chambers
Post-office address Goodsprings, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0081 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 cattle and 10 horses
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 28, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a drilled well 115 feet deep equipped with a windmill with a 3 inch cylinder. The water is conveyed to a round trough 20 feet in diameter and 30 inches deep through 30 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe. The place of use is at the trough in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
