CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. A. Blair, Rancher has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Six Mile Well) through well, pump and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 8 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 34 bears S. 52° 05' W., 2,230 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. A. Blair
Post-office address Hot Creek Ranch, Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 155 feet deep cased with 5 inch casing. Water is conveyed to two 500 gallon troughs each 15 feet long, 5 feet wide and 2 1/2 feet deep with rounded bottoms and to another trough 23 feet long, 2 1/2 feet wide and 1 1/2 feet deep. The place of use is at the troughs located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
